EVANS, Mr. Columbus - age 63, passed away Wednesday, June 11, 2014 at Horacio Oduber Hospital-Oranjestad, Aruba. Family hour 10 a.m. Saturday, June 21, 2014 at Vermont Christian Church, 1201 Lippincott Blvd. with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Rev. Andre Powell officiating. Interment Lovedale Memorial Cemetery, 5175 E. Bristol Rd., Burton, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Church 10 a.m. Saturday. Mr. Evans will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd. and may be viewed from 12 p.m.-8 p.m. Friday.

Columbus “Bug” Evans, Jr., was born on September 11, 1950 in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, the son of Columbus Evans, Sr. And Vernie Cooksey. He passed away unexpectedly. Mr. Evans was a resident of Mt. Morris, MI, and an active member of Vermont Christian Church, where he formerly served as Trustee, Chair of the Finance Department and a member of the Christian Men's Fellowship. Columbus received his Diploma from Townsend Park High School, attended UAPB and received an Associate Degree from Mott Community College. Columbus worked at Delphi as a Skilled Trades Supervisor, where he retired after 35 years of service. “Bug” loved to work out at the YMCA, fix things (especially cars), loved to travel; most of all he loved his family. Columbus loved people, he never met a stranger and became friends with everyone he met.

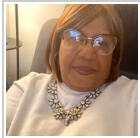

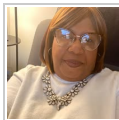
