Mr. Cornelius Williams Jr. also known as "Lil Brother", "Pee Wee", "Lil Un" was born in Pioneer, Louisiana on April 18, 1933, the son of the late Cornelius and Daisy (Marshall) Williams. He left for a few years with his mother until the age of seven and then rejoined his father and bonus mother Mary (Leggett) Williams who raised him until adulthood in Pioneer, Louisiana. Lil Brother loved spreading out and growing up with his favorite uncles and cousins, Joe, Willie and Barbra on his grandparents farm.

Lil Brother accepted Christ at an early age. He attended Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church with his family. He graduated from Magnolia high school in Pioneer.

When he moved to Flint, Michigan, he met and married Lorene Rice. They married and had two children, Michael and Yvonne. He joined Foss Avenue

Baptist Church and was a faithful member until the time of his passing. On April 25, 1987 he married the late Consuella Williams. She passed away in 2006 and they were married for 20 years. Lil Brother retired from General Motors at 47 dedicated years. After retiring he spent his free time fishing, hunting and playing cards for fun with his buddies.

For many years Lil Brother was also known as the "Sweet Potato Man", bringing the jewels of Louisiana to Michigan for people to enjoy. He would bring truckloads of sweet potatoes with his brother Oscar so that the people here in Flint could enjoy freshly dug Louisiana sweet potatoes until the economy hit and the high cost prohibited him from bringing more.

Lil Brother loved his family. He had a big heart with tight hugs and always had a story that would send you into a fit of laughter. He had an ear, a voice of reason and dose of forgiveness for all. He was deeply endeared by his family.
