Ms. Crystal Lashun Sumpter was born May 11, 1966 in Flint, Michigan, the daughter of Charles Edward and Willene Sumpter. She accepted Christ at an early age at Vernon Chapel African Methodist Episcopal Church under the leadership of Pastor Rueben E. Russell. Crystal was an active Satellite Member of Redemptive Life Ministries in Dyersburg, TN led by Pastor Veronica Crudup for the past 15 years. She graduated and was Class President at Beecher High School, "Class of 1984." Crystal received a Bachelor of Health Care Administration from the University of Michigan. She was employed by Genesee Bank for 5 years, UAW-GM Legal Services for 10 years and Genesee District Library for 15 years. Crystal enjoyed reading the Word of God first and foremost, both fiction and non-fiction novels. She was a former volleyball and bowling enthusiast. 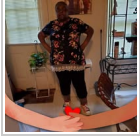
