Mr. Curtis "Bird" Flynn, Jr. was born December 20, 1946 in Fortsmith, Arkansas, the son of Curtis L.T. and Lorene Flynn, Sr. Curtis was a resident of Flint for over 38 years, before relocating to Montrose, Michigan. He was a dedicated and loyal employee of Buick, a division of General Motors for 31 years, retiring in 1995 and was a member of UAW Local #599. Curtis graduated from Flint Northern High School, "Class of 1965", where they won State Championships in 1964 and 1965 in Wrestling. He also was Captain of 3 Championship State Teams. Curtis had scholarships from Iowa and Nebraska Colleges both "Big Penn colleges." and many other colleges throught the United States. He was a Wrestling Coach at Beecher High School and other schools. Curtis enjoyed gardening, his cars, animals, hats, hunting and cooking, especially tacos. He also enjoyed watching sports on television with his son, Cortez. Curtis was a very devoted husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather.
