HARRIS, Deacon Curtis James - Age 73, passed away Wednesday, February 12, 2020 at his residence. Family hour 10:00 AM Friday, February 21, 2020 at Cathedral of Faith Ministries C.O.G.I.C., 6031 Dupont St., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM. Pastor Chris Martin, officiating. Deacon Curtis James Harris of Flint, Michigan went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, February 12, 2020 at his residence.

Curtis was born on April 11, 1946 in Eudora, Arkansas. He was the son of Clifton and Willie B. (Doll) Harris. After graduating from East High school in Eudora, AR in 1965, he moved to Flint, Michigan to pursue a career with General Motors Corporation. Curtis worked for General Motors for 31 years and was a member of the UAW #599. He retired in 1996.

Deacon Curtis James Harris married Bonnie Gibson in 1971. From their union produced three children: Curtis Jr (Kirk), Hannah, and Algeretta. Curtis began attending Harris Temple C.O.G.I.C. in 1973, where he accepted Christ under the leadership of the late Superintendent T.R. Harris and subsequently the late Bishop Walter E. Bogan Sr. He later joined Cathedral of Faith C.O.G.I.C.

under the leadership of Superintendent Christopher Martin, where he served on the Deacon Board.

Curtis enjoyed singing and playing the guitar. He was also a member of the quartet singing group, The Mighty Gospel Shepherds of Flint, MI. In 1987, Curtis recorded his first gospel album entitled "Lord I'm Thankful" and in 1991, he recorded a second gospel album.
