DUNCAN, Ms. Cynthia - Age 57, passed away Wednesday, March 22, 2017 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 1:30 PM Friday, March 31, 2017 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Cynthia Marie Duncan was born September 26, 1959 in Flint, Michigan, the daughter of Joan and Roosevelt Duncan. She was a resident of Flint and graduated from Flint Northern High School. Cynthia played on the Varsity Basketball Team. She often made the front page news in The Flint Journal newspaper for her amazing athletic abilities. Cynthia was known as a "Cent Dunk". During 1975-1976, Cynthia along with Gail Keith, Linda Cheeks and Martina Thompson called themselves The Fantastic Four were instrumental in Northern High School winning the District Championship and making it to the Regional Play-Offs. She was presented a Key To The City by the Mayor of Flint that year. Cynthia also played on the AAU Basketball Team for Berston Field House. She was well known for her phenomenal skills in Fast Pitch Softball which she also played at Berston Field House. Cynthia gave her life to Christ at an early age. She was a faithful member of Joy Tabernacle Church where

she served as the Youth Sunday School Teacher for eleven plus years. Cynthia diligently participated in Bible Study and Prayer Services. She was the Former President of the Choir. Cynthia was employed at General Motors Corporation. In 2009, Cynthia was inducted into the Sacred Heart Spiritual Society where her love for Christ was strengthened. She graduated from Mott Community College in 2014 with honors receiving an Associate Degree in Applied Science and Social Work Technician. Cynthia completed a Peer Recovery Coach Training Program with Recovery Allies of West Michigan and went on to complete her internship with Genesee County Health Systems. She was a member of Narcotic Anonymous (NA) for over 12 years where she shared the gift of recovery touching the lives of many. She leaves a legacy of "I Am My Brothers Keeper" for us to follow. Cynthia will forever be remembered for her balloons, teddy bears and her mottos "Way To Grow Way To Glo" "If you don't put it in you, it can't do nothing to you." And best of all "Blessed By The Best." We will always and forever miss the light that illuminated the room whenever she entered it, carrying that light everywhere she went and filling everyone around her with her light, her joy, inspiration and most of all her unconditional love.

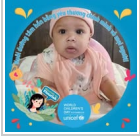

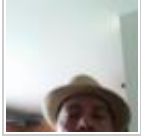

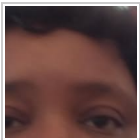
