Mrs. Daisy Elizabeth Jackson was born April 18, 1918 in Greenville, Kentucky. She was the daughter of Tobias and Lilly Goins. Daisy was the youngest of 10 children. She attended Roosevelt High School in Gary, Indiana. Daisy placed 1st Runner-Up in Elks Lodge Beauty Contest in 1941. She married Melvin Hopson, Jr. in 1934 in Greenville, Kentucky. Daisy married James Henry Jackson in Flint, Michigan in 1939, they opened Jackson's take out in 1957 on Lapeer Road in Flint and had "the best hand packed ice cream in the city". Together they shared 63 years, until his passing in 2002. Even though she had one son, she raised a multitude of children on the south side. Daisy liked going fishing and hunting. She also enjoyed playing pinochle and bid whist. Mrs. Daisy Elizabeth Jackson leaves to cherish her memory: son, Melvin Jackson; 3 grandchildren, Andre (Ursena) Jackson of Flint, Lori Jackson of Dallas, TX, Sonya Jackson of Flint; and 6 great-grandchildren.
