JACKSON, Mrs. Daisy "Cutie"— Age 76, succumbed to this life, Tuesday, October 13, 2009 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Family hour 10AM Saturday, October 24, 2009 at Bethlehem Temple Church of the Apostolic Faith, 3401 M. L. King Ave., with funeral service commencing at 11AM, Eld. Phillip J. Thompson officiating. Mrs. Daisy "Cutie" Jackson was born April 3, 1933 in Greenville, Georgia, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John (Elizabeth Render) Chaney, Sr. Mrs. Jackson received her education in Georgia. Thereafter, in 1950, she traveled north to Detroit and later to Flint, where she took up residency. Mother Jackson was a faithful member of Bethlehem Temple for many years, serving in various capacities. She was affiliated with the Odyssey House (as a den mother) and G-CARD Food Bank. Mrs. Jackson was both an adopted mother and foster mother. She was recognized for receiving close to 300 disarray mothers and children in her home over a 30-year span. Mrs. Jackson also addressed the needs for the helpless, homeless and hopeless, representing and fighting in their stead. She leaves to cherish a rich and God-blessed legacy: son, Marcellus (Deborene) Jackson: daughters, Diana Gilbert, Pamela (Leroy) White and Portia (Michael) Washington; adopted children, Monica R., Sean, Taleatha, Marcia and Monica Jackson; 24 grandchildren; 28
