With honor, Mr. Robinson served in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict, where he earned the respect of his commanding officers and fellow soldiers. In 1954, he was honorably discharged from the Armed Forces and moved to Flint, MI. He was employed with GM Buick Motor Division for 35 years, retiring in 1989. He was also a member of UAW Local #599. Mr. Robinson was united in Holy Matrimony to Kay Frances McMullan in October 1967, and was happily married for 35years. Dan was taught the word of God and enjoyed reading his Holy Bible. He was a fan of boxing, baseball and auto racing.
