Mr. Dave Lenear, Jr. was born May 28, 1929 in Bolivar, Tennessee, the son of Dave and Lugenia Lenear. He met and married his wife, Marie, at an early age, and they were united in Holy Matrimony for 61 years before her death in December 2006. Dave was a devoted father who provided for his family and extended family all of his life. He retired from Grand Blanc Metal Fab in 1999 after 46 years of dedicated service where he was a member of UAW Local 1292, along with 25 years of service at Firestone South Saginaw Street location. Dave resided in Flint for 55 years. He enjoyed working, walking and sitting in the comfort of his favorite chairs – indoors and out. Dave could also be found eating handfuls of his favorite sweets.
