



## Mr. David Booth

BOOTH, Mr. David, age 55, passed away on Wednesday, February 11, 2015 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Saturday, February 21, 2015 at Church of Trinity Pentecostal, 421 E 12th St., with funeral services commencing at 11 a.m. Bishop Rosal McFadden officiating. Interment Gracelawn Community Cemetery, G-5710 N. Saginaw St. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church at 10:30 a.m. Mr. Booth will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Mr. David Booth was born on March 22, 1959, the son of Major and Cora Lee Booth. Although originally from Little Rock, AR, the family moved to Flint, MI where he graduated from Beecher High school, "Class of 1977". After years of labor and dedication, Mr. Booth retired from General Motors.

A God fearing man, Mr. Booth was a member of Church of Trinity Pentecostal, where he regularly attended. Outside of attending church, a few of his favorite pass times were fishing and spending time with his family. Most of all he loved playing bass guitar.
