As a father, he excelled them all. David gave meaning to the term in so many ways – his presence, his support, his example, and love was consistent throughout his life. He provided support to his children's hopes and dreams no matter the cost and worked hard to help them pursue opportunities and develop skills that would lead to independence. "Day-Day" taught them values of integrity, responsibility, and love. He often took out time to take them

Although, he had strict rules to protect them, he also knew how to let them spread their wings and fly once the time came although it was not always easy. David was known for being a seeker of knowledge and seemed to have information on all subjects like a walking encyclopedia. He analyzed life through math, science, and nature. 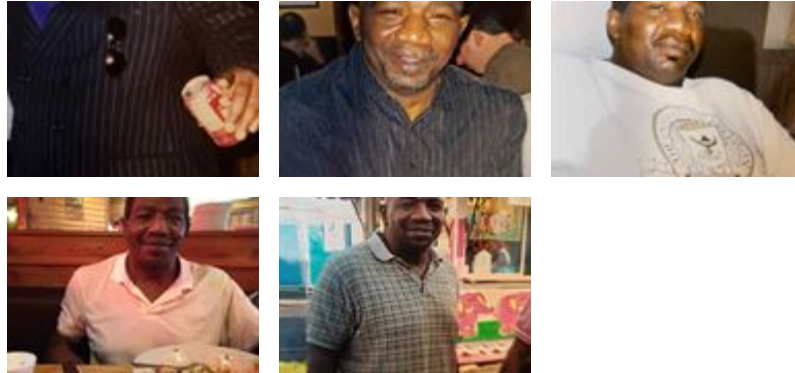

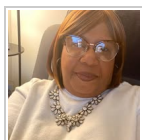
