COOK, Rev. David George Jr. - Age 58, passed away Tuesday, October 25, 2022 in Hazel Park, MI. Family hour 1:30 PM Saturday, November 5, 2022 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing at 2:00 PM. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Chapel Saturday, November 5, 2022 at 1:30 PM. Rev. Cook will lie in state in the chapel of Lawrence E. Moon funeral home and may be viewed Friday, November 4, 2022 from 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM. Rev. David George Cook Jr. was born December 6, 1963 in Dallas County, Selma, Alabama, the son of the late Deacon David G. Sr. and Delois Marie (Thomas) Cook. David confessed Christ at an early age and was baptized and joined Zion Hill Bible under the leadership of the late Rev. James R. Thomas in Flint, Michigan. In 1986, he was installed as Pastor of Zion Hill Bible Church and the name was later changed to Greater Zion Hill Bible Church. On May 23, 1996, he was united in Holy Matrimony to Veattia C. Johnson and from this union a wonderful blended family was formed of sons and daughters. He was the founder of New Hope Word of Life, which he was so proud of doing. After moving to Hazel Park, Michigan, he joined Temple of St. Jude. He was on the Ministerial Board and at one point on the Men's Board of Metropolitan Spiritual Church, which he was still affiliated with.
