MOSLEY, Mr. David - Age 91, passed away on Wednesday, October 22, 2025 in Burton, MI. Family hour 1:30PM Friday, November 7, 2025, from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing at 2:00PM. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, 4413 Flushing Rd, Flint, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the funeral home 1:30PM Friday. Deacon David Mosley was born on August 21, 1934, in Hughes, Arkansas. Born, the 8th child out of 12 to Earlie and Hattie B. Mosley. David had no choice but to affirm his faith early in life and began a spiritual journey that guided him throughout his days. Not only were Earlie and Hattie B. his parent's, but they were also his Pastor and Founders of Green River Church Of God In Christ in Anthonyville, Arkansas.

David moved to Flint, Michigan in 1954. He then began a 45-year career with General Motors, ending it at the engine plant. He eventually made Freedom Temple Church of God In Christ under the leadership of Elder Williams his final church home. David obtained the title of Deacon while serving at

Freedom Temple. Many things could be said about David. Such words as dapper, dashing, snappy, spiffy, fashionable, or sugar sharp comes to mind. These words would describe his style of dress. Not just any suit would do. A 3-piece combo was a must! Not every man could rock the long jacket, and those vest! No suit was complete until it had the coordinating hat and shiny shoes to match! He would be the first and the last on the runway at the family reunion modeling his latest suits. But today as we all can see, David is Easter Sharp! Exactly how he would have dressed himself. Some more words to describe David could be greedy, gluttonous, insatiable, or just hungry. But David was simply a Connoisseur of good food! You would know when the food was good, because he would tell you when it wasn't. Wrapping a plate to go after he had already eaten, was a compliment to the cook. He was an ornery, yet prideful man. He looked out for family and friends in need. He encouraged family to come together and looked forward to family reunions and picnics. No matter where we gathered, he kept his travelling shoes shined and Cadillac ready to go.

David looked forward to road trips home, "South" for Easter Sunday and Mother's Day or just because. Often going home up to 3-4 times a year. If he had another driver, it was guaranteed that he would swing through Indianapolis for his sister Mattie and a meal before heading home to West Memphis. After retirement, the things that brought David joy were watching baseball, he was a "Hometown Fan" of the Detroit Tigers; he watched wrestling and surprisingly played pool and was good at it! He went fishing with his grandson Perignon and friend Doris often. If they caught anything, Doris would make sure she would cook it. A highlight that started many of his days was breakfast and men's talk at Golden Gate or Coty's with his breakfast buddies, grandson, Perignon; cousin, John; and son-in-law, Lloyd.
