WALKER, Mr. David - Age 66, passed away Saturday, November 22, 2014 at Willowbrook Manor. Family hour 11 a.m. Friday, December 5, 2014 at Antioch Missionary Baptist Church, 1083 E. Stewart Ave., with funeral service commencing at 12 noon. Pastor Lewis Randolph officiating. Family and friends will assemble at the church 11 a.m. Friday. Mr. Walker will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12 noon- 8 p.m. Thursday.

David Walker entered this life on January 1st, 1948, in Crawfordsville, Arkansas. His was the third youngest child of 12 children, born to the late Cornelius Sr. and Alma Walker. The family relocated to Flint Michigan in 1958, where he continued his primary education. While in high school, David obtained a position with General Motors as general laborer. During his senior year in high school, he requested permission to attend his prom; exposing his true age. He was granted permission to attend the prom, graduating from Northwestern High School in 1967.

Because of his work ethic, commitment and dedication, General Motors allowed him to continue his employment. David continued his employment with General Motors, retiring in 2000 after 35 ½ years of employment. David loved fishing, listening to Jazz, nice cars and most of all, he loved the Lord. As a small child, David attended Antioch Baptist Church with his mother. He gave

his life to Christ and later became a Deacon and a faithful member of Antioch. His Baritone voice delighted our heart and soul as a member of the choir.

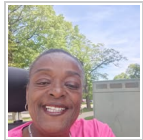
