He confessed Christ at an early age. Roger was a resident of Flint for 53 years. He was employed at Buick, a division of General Motors Corporation for 44 years and was a member of UAW Local #599, before retiring in 1996. He served in the United States Army from 1956 to 1958 and was honorably discharged. Dea. Stallings was a member of House of Prayer Missionary Baptist Church and faithfully served as Deacon and Trustee until his illness and death. He was a former member of the Southern Gentlemens' Club. Dea. Stallings was a father figure to the children of the neighborhood who named him "Smooth". In his earlier years he excelled in baseball and basketball. Dea.
