Mr. McNeal received his education from the Pike County School System in Troy, Alabama after which, he enlisted in the U.S. Army and was Honorably Discharged November 1, 1952. Harris returned to Troy, AL where he owned and operated a cab service for approximately two years. He then relocated to Michigan and became employed by General Motors where he retired after 30 years of service. He was an active and devoted member of Mt.
