Deacon McGee received his formal education in the Tunica County School System. He served in the United States Army and received an honorable discharged. Deacon McGee met the love of his life Inez McGee and they were united in Holy Matrimony on November 26, 1956, and later relocated to Flint, MI. and was employed Fisher Body Plant, Grand Blanc. He retired in 1981 after 30 years of employment. In 1990 he accepted Christ as his personal savior and united with the Harris Memorial COGIC. In June 1997, he joined in fellowship with Supt. Steve A. Hawkins; where he continued to be a faithful supporter of the Ministry and the Pastor. Deacon McGee loved to study and teach the Word of God; he served as an Adult Sunday School

Teacher and Chairman of the Deacon's Board. Deacon McGee was an avid hunter and fisherman; and he loved to spend time with family and friends.
