Lawrence served in World War II and was Honorably Discharged. After serving, Mr. Golden moved to Flint, MI and retired from Buick, a division of General Motors after 38 years of service. He also worked at Davis Auto Sales for 17 years. Lawrence was united in Holy Matrimony to Ms. Helen Blanche Elliott on May 14, 1948.
