Family hour 10 a.m. Saturday, May 29, 2010 at New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, 1035 E. Carpenter Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m., Bishop Odis A. Floyd officiating. Interment Great Lakes National Cemetery, G-4200 Belford Rd., Holly, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11 a.m. Saturday. Deacon Scott will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12 Noon-8 p.m. Friday. Deacon William Harvey Scott III was born November 9, 1947 in South Bend, Indiana, the oldest of 10 children to William and Josephine Scott, Sr. Deacon Scott was a resident of Flint, Michigan for 34 years. He was Chairman of New Jerusalem Deacon Board. Scott "June Boy" graduated in 1966 from John Adams High in South Bend, Indiana and was an exceptional Track Star. "Scotty" retired from Chevrolet V-8 Flint Engine South a division of General Motors, as a skilled trade journeyman (painter-glazer) on August 1, 2006.
