She attended Flint Northwestern High School and graduated in 1971. Deborah was an employee of General Motors where she retired after 28 years and worked for Chip's Shrimp & Fish-Bristol Road. She volunteered at Hurley Medical Center and was a student tutor for Manley Elementary School. Deborah loved to golf and traveled to visit friends and family. She was the owner of Dee's Meaty Tacos where she was a vendor at the Flint and Grand Blanc Farmer's Markets.
