



Mr. Decellar Spencer

April 18, 1922 - January 27, 2019

SPENCER, Mr. Decellar - Age 96, passed away Sunday, January 27, 2019 at his residence. Family hour 10AM Monday, February 4, 2019 at Mt. Olive Baptist Church, 424 Kennelworth Ave. with funeral service commencing at 11AM. Pastor Jevon Catlett, Host Pastor, Rev. Ronald Wilson, officiating. Interment Flint Memorial Park, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy., Mt. Morris, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM Monday. Mr. Spencer will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd. and may be viewed 10AM-6PM Sunday. Mr. Spencer was Honorably Discharged from the United States Army.

Mr. Decellar Spencer was born April 18, 1922 in Albany, GA the youngest of six children born to Merrill and Rosa (Jones) Spencer. Mr. Spencer enlisted in the United States Army, October 29, 1940. This tour of duty was in the Southwest Pacific where he obtained the rank of Staff Sergeant. Staff Sergeant Decellar Spencer was a member of the prestigious and now famous 555th Paratrooper Infantry Battalion, nicknamed the "Triple Nickels". He returned to Flint and began working for the United States Postal Services. He worked from 1945 to 1947 and is believed to have been among the first black male postal clerks in Flint, Michigan.

Mr. Spencer re-enlisted in the Army in 1949. This tour of duty lasted from November 1947 to February 1952. Sergeant Decellar Spencer's military

service totaled 8 years, 9 months and 11 days. He was awarded the Bronze Star along with many other military honors. He was extremely proud to tell family and friends about his military service and his honor to be chosen to be a "Triple Nickel". He was a member of the VFW Post 3291 located in Flint, MI. After the military, Mr. Spencer worked and retired from General Motors. In retirement he continued his strong work ethic and enjoyed landscaping and for a while driving a school bus. His great enjoyment came from helping those he loved. He mentored young men encouraging them to be loving fathers, and to take care of their families. He was an excellent cook as well as a skilled auto body Repair Man.

In 1948 he married the love of his life, Bobbie Wilson. They were the parents of two sons, Rene' (deceased) and Kevin, granddaughter Trina and great-grandson, Blake.

In 1979 he married Connie Elzy, who preceded him in death. Mr. Spencer became the loving step-father to Connie's children, Denise (Michael) white of Shady Spring, West VA; 3 grandchildren, Dirk Turhan Elzy (deceased) grandson, Willie (Celeste) Elzy of Flint, 3 grandchildren including Sgt. Josiah Elzy, Lisa Elzy Watson(1 granddaughter) and Tanya Elzy, both of Bakersfield, CA. Other surviving loved ones include: daughter-in-law, Priscilla "Pat" Spencer; sister-in-law, Edith Prunty Spencer; niece, Gwendolyn Watkins all of Flint; nieces, Robbie Grier of Dallas, TX, Gail (Dr. Leroy) Johnson, Rose Richardson, Margreat (Leon) Handley, all of Flint; nephews, Merrill Richardson of Flint, Terrell Richardson of Tennessee; goddaughter, Nisha Ross, close friend Julius Ross and Michael Mason,; and numerous great nephew and nieces.

Mr. Decellar Spencer was preceded in death by his parents, Merrill and Rosa Spencer, sisters, Rosa Richardson and Lucille Blassingame; brothers, Bud, Dr. J. Merrill and John Spencer.

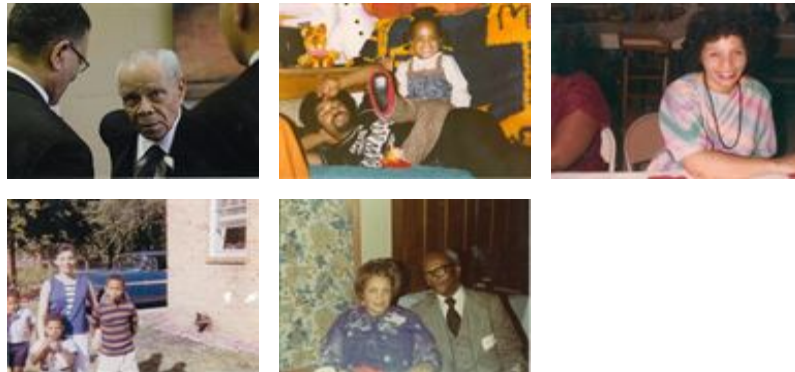
