Ms. Deloris Lots was born April 1, 1946 in Memphis, Tennessee, the daughter of William Fenner and Izola (Gray) Fenner, Sr. Deloris began working for Hurley Medical Center in 1970 as a Nurse Transcriber. She was involved in AFSCME Local 1603 for over 33 years. Deloris started as a 2nd shift steward in 1976 under President Joe Abraham. She was a member of the negotiating team for 23 years and served on the J.U.M.P. Committee. Deloris also was the first Vice President from 1988 until 1994 and the bargaining chairperson from 1994 until 2006. She then went on to become President from 2006 until her passing.
