MULLEN, Mr. Demetrise L. - Age 36, passed away Tuesday, October 27, 2009 in Marquette, MI. Family hour 10AM Saturday, November 7, 2009 at Mt. Sinai Missionary Baptist Church, 1215 E. Downey St., with funeral service commencing at 11AM, Pastor Morris A. Collins, Sr., officiating. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM Saturday. Mr. Mullen will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 4-8PM Friday. Mr. Demetrise Mullen was born March 11, 1973 in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the son of Gregory E. Mullen and Barbara A. Ansley (Isaiah) Salley. He was a 1991 graduate of Flint Hamady High School and a 1996 graduate of Northern Michigan University in Marquette, MI, where he earned his Bachelors of Science degree. Mr. Mullen was a member of the Northern Michigan University Football team from 1991-1996. He was also active as a coach with the POP Warner Football Program in Marquette. Demetrise was employed by the Marquette Branch Prison in Marquette, MI since 1996 as Administrative Assistant to the Warden. He was a member and Past Master of Marquette Masonic Lodge 101 and a member of the Scottish Rite. Mr. Demetrise Mullen leaves to cherish his memory: two sons, Demetrise L. Mullen, Jr., Desmond L.
