GAYDEN, Mother Dessie "Dee" - Age 89, passed away Saturday, March 13, 2010 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Family hour 10AM Saturday, March 20, 2010 at New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, 1085 E. Carpenter Rd., with funeral service commencing immediately at 11AM. Pastor Frederick L. Mother Dessie Gayden "Dee" was born January 27, 1921 in DuValls Bluff, Arkansas, the youngest of nine children born to Lawrence and Nancy Tyms. Mother Gayden has been a resident of Flint for the past 69 years and was a member of Promise Tabernacle Church, where she was a member of the Mother's Board and where she served the community through the Goldenleaf Neighborhood Services. She loved to cook, bake and sew. Her specialty items were her barbeque sauce, peach cobbler and dinner rolls. On May 12, 1941, Mother Dessie Gayden married Andrew L. "Buster" Gayden, Sr. in Pontiac, Michigan and to this union six children were born. Mother Gayden leaves to cherish her memory: 4 daughters, Yvonne (John) Royster of Detroit, MI, Bethany Gayden and Sharon Holmes both of Grand Blanc, MI and Patricia Mayfield of Flint; 2 sons, Andrew (Nina) Gayden, Jr. of Flushing, MI and Eld.
