TISDALE, Mr. Dewrell Allen - Age 39, passed away Monday, December 21, 2009 in Houston, Texas. Family hour 11AM Wednesday, December 30, 2009 at Joy Missionary Baptist Church, 670 E. Carpenter Rd., with funeral service commencing at 12Noon, Pastor James Searcy officiating. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11AM Wednesday. Mr. Tisdale will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 9AM-8PM Tuesday. Mr. Dewrell A. Tisdale was born March 7, 1970 in Flint, Michigan, the son of Judy Tisdale-Moore and the late Allen Henry Jones. Dewrell accepted Christ at an early age and was a member of the Joy Missionary Baptist Church, where he served on the Security Ministry. He was a big kid at heart and loved spending time with his children, nieces, nephews and family. Dewrell moved to Texas after dating Tonyah Vinson for three years. While in South Padre Island, he spent his time fishing and hanging out on the beach. He also, volunteered at Kids By The Bay Learning Center, The Boys and Girls Club and helped with the Annual Cancer walk for women. Dewrell and Tonyah were married September 5, 2009.
