Mrs. Forte will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10 a.m.-6 p.m. Sunday. Ms. Dixie Dianella Moore-Forte was the first born to Ivy and Dianella Laverne Moore on November 1, 1947 in Noxapater, Mississippi. Dixie accepted Christ at an early age at Mt. Pleasant Missionary Baptist Church #2 in Noxapater, MS. Dixie attended Flint Public Schools. She retired as Postmaster from the United States Post Office after 37 years of service. Dixie was a member of Ebenezer Ministries, where she served on the Missionary Society. Her favorite song was "I Won't Complain." Ms. Dixie D.
