IRELAND, Jr. Mr. Dolph - Age 68, passed away Thursday, July 9, 2015 at Genesys Health Park - Grand Blanc, MI. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Saturday, July 18, 2015 at Bethlehem Temple Church Of The Apostolic Faith, 3401 M.L. King Ave. with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor Phillip Thompson officiating. Mr. Dolph B. Ireland was born October 4, 1946 in Crawford, Mississippi, the son of J.D. Malone and Irene Rice Ireland. Dolph "Bug", was an avid gardener who also enjoyed riding his tractor and fishing. He worked for the General Motors Corporation for fifteen years, retiring in 1982. Dolph was a member of the Rose of Sharon Lodge No. 4, A.F. and A.M. He was a member of the New Life Missionary Baptist Church, where the Pastor Wilbert Campbell presides. Dolph enjoyed the gospel quartet group, The Pilgrim Jubilees, and was a lover of the blues. He was well known throughout the city of Flint and Beecher areas because of his cowboy attire.

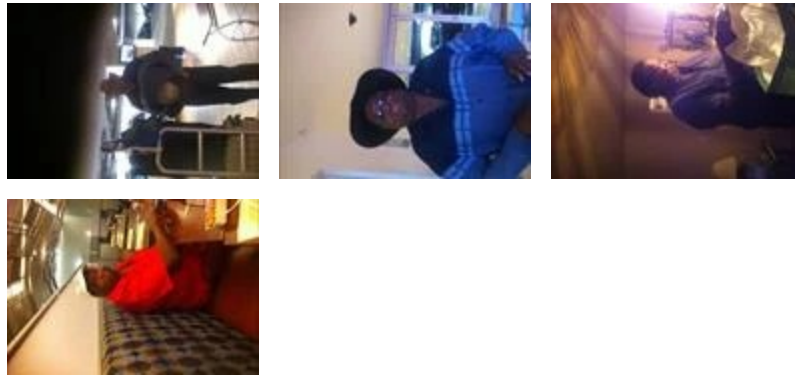
