BELL, Mr. Donald - Age 79, passed away Tuesday, November 1, 2016 at his residence. Family hour 10:00 AM Wednesday, November 9, 2016 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Mr. Donald Bell was born October 17, 1937 in Flint, Michigan, the son of Jeff and Willie Bell. He was affectionately known as "Superman" to his friends and family. He made his transition on November 1, 2016. Donald was a life-long resident of Flint. He attended Flint Public Schools, graduating from Flint Northern High School, where he also starred on the football team and excelled in his architecture class. Donald served in the military, enlisting in 1955. He fought in the Vietnam War and received an Honorable Discharge in 1959. Donald had a strong belief in the unity of family and was devoted to his 3 children, Jeff, Michelle and Tracy. He retired from General Motors on September, 1, 2005 after 33 years of service, most proudly being a Journeyman Model Maker. He met his wife, Stella Morris-Bell in 2001 and they married in 2008. 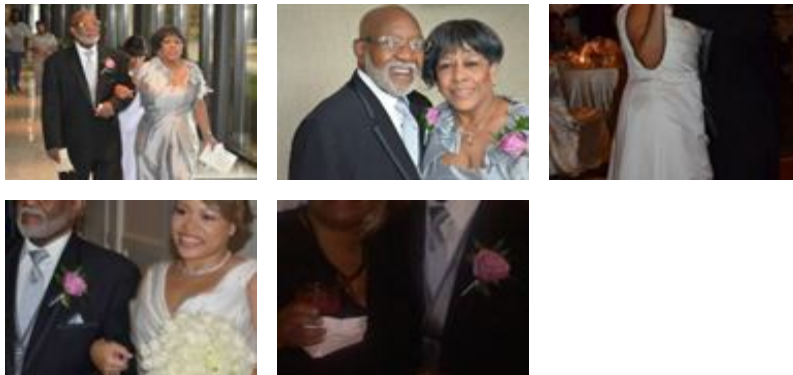
