Dorothy was a resident of Flint, Michigan for 61 years where she briefly worked for Herrlich Drugstore and Meijer before finding employment with AC Spark Plug, (which later became Delphi), in 1979. Mrs. Brock had over 30 years with General Motors before retiring in 2014.

Mrs. Dorothy was raised in church and received the gift of the Holy Ghost in her early 20's. She was baptized years later at Bethlehem Temple Church of the Apostolic Faith. Mrs. Brock truly loved the Lord with all of her heart and attended Refuge Temple regularly.
