COLEMAN, Mrs. Dorothy Mae - Age 75, passed away Monday, March 20, 2023, her residence. Mrs. Coleman will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed Thursday, March 30, 2023, from 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM. Dorothy Owens Coleman, 75 of Grand Blanc, Michigan, departed this life on March 20, 2023, after a courageous battle with cancer. She was a wonderful mother, devoted grandmother, loving aunt, cousin, and friend. Dorothy was born on May 24, 1947, to the late Ida B. Owens in Louisville, Mississippi. Dorothy graduated from Louisville Colored High School in 1966 where she excelled academically and was a talented majorette. She went on to graduate from Mott Community College with an Associate Degree in Engineering. Dorothy was the first African American female in Flint, Michigan to obtain her journeyman card as a Skill Trades Worker (Tool and Die Maker). After working for General Motors for 40 years, she retired in 2013. Throughout her life she was very creative and after her retirement, Dorothy spent her past time working Crossword puzzles, crafting, sewing, and shopping. Dorothy was preceded in death by her mother, daughter, Melissa Coleman; sister, Ida Mae Jackson; and brother, Jim Owens. Dorothy leaves to cherish her memory: her daughter, Katrina Coleman; her son, Troy Coleman; her granddaughters, Joi Coleman and Madisyn Coleman; numerous nieces, nephews, a host of other relatives and friends. Dorothy touched the lives of so many people throughout her life, was loved by many and will be greatly missed.
