Mrs. Dorothy J. Newhouse was born November 20, 1944 in Hope Arkansas, the first born child of Eddie and Selma Wyatt. After the death of her mother, she dedicated her life to raising her younger siblings. She graduated from Yerger High School in Hope, Arkansas and moved to Marshall, Texas to attend Hurd's Beauty and Barber College. There she met James Newhouse and on June 1, 1964 they were married. To this union four children were born.

After moving to Flint, Dorothy united with the Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Granville Smith. There she was active on the Usher Board.
