Mrs. Dorothy Louise Simpson was born in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, the daughter of Mrs. Charlie Lee Walker. Dorothy was a graduate of Flint Central High School. She also attended Baker College. Dorothy was united in marriage to Rodney Simpson and this union brought six children. She was a hard worker and a great provider for her family. Dorothy retired from A.C. Spark Plugs, a division of General Motors with 38 years of service. Following this, she gained employment for another 11 years with the Flint Board of Education. She was a faithful member of St. Paul Baptist Church for over 50 years, where she served on the Usher Board, Mother's Board, taught Sunday school and sang in the Choir.

Dorothy was also a member of the Easter Star Order for several years. She

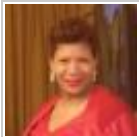
