Dralecea accepted Christ at an early age at Mt. Hermon Missionary Baptist Church, later becoming a member at Second Chance Missionary Baptist Church and finally House of Prayer Missionary Baptist Church. She graduated from Flint Northern High School "Class of 2006" and was currently attending classes at C. S. Mott College. Dralecea was a loving and kind young lady, with an outgoing, adventurous, generous spirit. She was a true songstress and musician; playing the clarinet and performing nationally.
