PERKINS, Bro. Earnest - Age 71, gained the victory when he went to be with the Lord on Friday, April 29, 2005 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10AM Saturday, May 7, 2005 at Mt. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM Saturday. Bro. Perkins will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Friday. Bro. Earnest Perkins began this journey of life on December 28, 1933 in Little Rock, Arkansas, the son of James and Berthola Bell Perkins. He grew up there and attended the Public Schools. After arriving in Flint in 1953, he became employed at Chevrolet Manufacturing, a division of General Motors, from which he retired after 38 years of service. His spiritual journey began at an early age when he accepted Christ as his personal Savior, and was baptized. Continuing his walk with the lord after coming to Flint, he united with the Mt. Calvary Baptist Church where he served faithfully as an usher until his illness. Traveling was his great passion. He was united in marriage to Ada Butler in 1954, and from that union 2 children were born. Bro.
