VICKERS, Mr. Earnest - Age 80, passed away Wednesday, December 7, 2005 at his residence. Family hour 10:30AM Friday, December 16, 2005 at Metropolitan Baptist Tabernacle, 930 E. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 5PM-8PM Thursday. Mr. Earnest Vickers, Sr. was born on May 1, 1922 in Scooba, Mississippi, the son of Willie and Dissie Vickers. At the age of 17, he joined the Army and worked his way up to the rank of Sergeant. After serving in the Army, he relocated to Flint and began a long career with Fisher Body, a division of General Motors. In 1951, he met and married his wife and future mother of his six children, Caroline Josephine Seaton. After 42 years with General Motors, he retired and devoted most of his time to his yard, his grandchildren and his dogs.
