She attended Dukette Catholic School and graduating from Flushing High School where she played Powder Puff Football. Due to her allergies, she was unable to pursue her love of sports and wanted to be a participant in some of everything. She graduated from Eastern University of Ann Arbor with an Associate Degree while working in the field of Customer Service for several Fortune 500 Hotel chains and handicapped facilities. Ebony held a host of employments in her career but her true passion was working with the community, young and old. During the pandemic she continued to work servicing seniors in need of groceries and/or home delivery services. After the pandemic she began teaching drivers education and she later became a team player at Stemnetics, (an after school program for children 5 to 14).

Ebony always had a smile on her face and greeted you with the love and

warmth of a hug. Even though her allergies prevented her from being an owner, Ebony had a great love for animals (especially dogs). Her greatest challenge was reaching into the warmth of her heart and inviting you in to find the good within you. No matter what you did she accepted you for who you were at all times. She loved teaching. Ebony loved...everyone unconditionally. She loved dancing and being silly. Ebony loved being with her family cooking and helping where she could. She had a great eye and mind for working with crafts and computer projects. Just tell her what you wanted, move out her way and...It Was Done. Ebony did catering to special events and weddings for her friends at no cost. She also delivered groceries to friends with limited mobility in Detroit. As much as she enjoyed cooking, she wasn't gonna touch NOOO meat! Who can cook without touching the meat! As a baby Ebony was christened at Dozier CME Church under the Pastoral Leadership of Rev. Littlejohn. Her love for Christ and wanting to know more about Him never stopped.
