



## Mr. Eddie Jordan

March 30, 1938 - June 21, 2017

JORDAN, Mr. Eddie - Age 79, passed away Wednesday, June 21, 2017 at Genesys Health Park in Grand Blanc, MI. Family hour 10:30 AM Saturday, July 1, 2017 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM. Interment Lovedale Memorial Cemetery, 5175 E. Bristol Rd., Burton, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the funeral home 10:30 AM Saturday. Mr. Jordan will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home and may be viewed from 2:00 PM - 8:00 PM Friday.

Eddie was born in Tuscaloosa, AL on March 30, 1938 to Mary Lou Duncan (Jordan) and Tommie Jordan. His parents relocated to Flint, MI when he was 4-years old. He is divorced. He confessed Christ at an early age and was baptized.

He graduated from Northern High School in 1957. He got his associates degree in mathematics from Genesee Community College in 1962 and bachelors degree in mathematics with a minor in physics along with a secondary Teacher Certification from Eastern Michigan University in 1965.

Eddie retired from the Internal Revenue Service after 19-years of service in 1990 where he was employed as a Systems Analyst and later as a Computer Specialist. After that, he worked at a health food store as a consultant.

Throughout the years, he worked as a substitute school teacher in various districts. His earlier work history includes employment at the Richard Theater as an usher and cashier; Robinson's Clothing Store as a sales associate; General Motors Fisher Body as a General Assembler, Detroit U.S. Post Office as a Transportation Clerk; Flint U.S. Post Office as a Burroughs Machine Operator; Detroit Board of Education as a Math Teacher; Flint Board of Education as a Data Processing Instructor; IBM as a Systems Engineer; Lincoln University as the Director of Data Processing; U.S. Dept of Agriculture as a Systems Analyst; after this, he started his career with the Internal Revenue Service. He broke many barriers in the work place. He received several letters of commendations; numerous awards and certificates for professional excellence, achievement, appreciation, merit as well as the USDA Outstanding Performance Award.

Eddie loved the Lord, his family, reading the Bible, listening to 1420AM radio station, helping people and researching vitamins and supplements. Each day, he recited 3 different prayers that he memorized. He loved traveling, fine dining, watching the news, sporting events, and playing chess and checkers. He mentored his younger siblings, nieces and nephews and was an inspiration to them. He was an advocate of the natural health movement and natural cures. He made it his life's mission to ensure the well-being of his older sister, Anna Ruth Thomas.
