Edmond, fondly known as "Pie" by his loved ones, was born on July 6, 1927, in Nash County, NC, to Elijah and Ada (nee Wright) Evans. As a young man, he was baptized at Pleasure Hill Baptist Church in Nash County, North Carolina, and his walk with the Lord grew over the years, enabling "Pie" to say to many, "It is well with my soul." "Pie," moved to Flint in 1953, and began working for General Motors Truck Assembly. He retired as a paint inspector from Chevrolet Truck & Bus in 1992 after completing 37 years of service.
