Mrs. Edna Lucille Willis was born in Marion, Ohio, the daughter of Samuel L. Smiley and Irene L. (Turner) Smiley Keys. Edna attended the Flint Public School System and was a graduate of the Hurley School of Nursing, where she became a Registered Nurse. Her nursing career included Hurley, McLaren, St. Joseph and Flint General Hospitals. Edna later became the instructor of Hurley Hospital teaching Nurse's Aide Classes. She was blessed with the gift of helping and continued her nursing career at Flint Public Health Department, where she was a Visiting Nurse for twelve years. During this period she ministered to the physical, emotional and spiritual body of her clients. In 1974, she transitioned to the Genesee County Health Department, as a Visiting Nurse. After ten years, she retired from the Genesee County Sheriff Department as Supervisor of Nursing. After her retirement, Edna relocated to Scottsdale, Arizona, where she continued helping in the area of

nursing at Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church. Edna served on the Nurse Ministry at Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church for over ten years.
