Eddie was raised and educated in Little Rock, Arkansas by his aunt Polly and uncle Lynch Handy. He later enlisted in the United States Army receiving an Honorable Discharge from WWII. He retired from General Motors with over 30 years of service. His hobbies included hunting, and fishing. Eddie was a Deacon at Heavenly Host Full Gospel Baptist Church. He was married to Theresa Cooley for over 40 years.
