He spent most of his professional career working on the assembly line at General Motors before retiring in 1987. Before and after retiring, he continued to work and develop businesses. "Ed" was a very good Salesman, Landlord and Motivator. He also went on to start his own weekly newspaper called, The Saginaw County Weekly Journal in Saginaw, Michigan in which he was CEO and Publisher; he published the news for well over 15 years.

After closing the newspaper, Edward who was an avid reader and who loved to learn, decided to continue his education at the University of Michigan-Flint, where he studied Arabic and World History. He later wanted to try his hand at another trade and studied Air Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Technology at Mott Community College until taking ill in 2008. "Ed" loved
