In 1951, Effie moved to Flint, Michigan with her son, James Horsley. Mrs. Powell retired from McLaren General Hospital in 1984 after 21 years of service. In 1991, she retired from General Motors with 13 years of service; and she was a member of UAW Local #5960. Mrs. Powell accepted Christ at an early age and continued her walk with the Lord throughout her life. She attended Antioch Baptist Church and later joined her husband at Metropolitan Baptist Tabernacle.
