CHANEY, Eld. Marion - Age 73, passed away Wednesday, December 8, 2010 at Genesys Health Park. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Saturday, December 18, 2010 at New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, 1035 E. Carpenter Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Min. Tommie Chaney Presiding, Apostle/Elder Dana Alan Chaney, Officiating/Eulogist, Bishop Odis A. Floyd, Host Pastor. Entombment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 a.m. Saturday. Eld. Chaney will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12 Noon-8 p.m. Friday. Elder Marion Chaney was born February 20, 1937 in Moro, Arkansas, the son of Milton and Pinnie (Moore) Chaney. Eld. Chaney was a resident of Flint, MI and a member of Father In Jesus Christ Church. He entered into Holy Matrimony with Cillia Ruth (McMullan), December 28, 1958. Eld. Chaney retired from Chevrolet Flint Manufacturing, where he was employed for over 30 years and was a member of UAW Local 659. After retirement he was a member of the Flint Police Dept. School Crossing Guard, where he was loved, cherished and where he also became a father figure to many. He was saved, sanctified and spirit filled, July 4, 1972. Eld. Chaney was ordained an Elder, Jan. 29, 2000. He possessed practically a photographic memory of the bible and scripture including chapters and verses. Eld. Chaney spent his entire life helping and supporting others! He loved and cherished his entire family! However, he loved his wife like Christ loved the church and he

gave his life for her. For those who knew him, his most famous quote when he had a biblical and spiritual revelation was, "I'm about to drop a bomb on you."
