DAVIS, Mrs. Eliza Lee - Age 89, passed away Tuesday, June 24, 2025, at her residence. Mrs. Eliza Lee Davis was born September 22, 1935 in Bradley, Arkansas, the daughter of Clarence and Bessie (Harris) Noble. She moved to Michigan in 1951 and married the love of her life, Jewel Davis Sr. on April 24, 1961. The union lasted fifty years until the death of her husband in 2011. Eliza was a lovable homemaker who raised 7 healthy children. She loved the Lord and instilled in her children the desire to have a consistency of strong faith in HIM. Eliza was a devoted member and Usher at God's Tabernacle of Truth Church until her health began to fail. When she could no longer be present, she ensured that her tithes were sent, until the church closed. She was an extraordinary cook and enjoyed caring for her home and family. Eliza was known for her creamed corn, fried chicken, sweet potato pies and her ability to turn simple ingredients into savory delights. She never found a need for a measuring cup or spoon, or a written recipe, but anyone who tasted her food raved about it and wanted more. If her family or church needed it made on top of the stove, in the oven or on the grill, she had

it covered. Eliza was shy and reserved but anyone who knew her, knew that she loved our Lord and her family. Her kind heart, her smile and her “little wiggle” dancing will be sorely missed by her family and all who knew her.
