HARRIS, Mrs. Elizabeth - Age 87, passed away Thursday, November 6, 2025, in Illinois. Family hour 10:30 AM Saturday, November 15, 2025, at New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, 1035 E. Carpenter Rd., with Celebration of Life service at 11:00 AM Pastor Alfred J. Harris II, Host Pastor Elder Veotis Jones, officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 AM Saturday. Mrs. Harris will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home and may be viewed during the family hour only.

Elizabeth Harris was born on September 29, 1938, to Frank and Bamma Harris in Cornerville, Arkansas. She was one of 20 children in the family. She graduated from Lincoln High School in Star City in 1957. At a young age, she accepted Christ as her savior at Strangers Rest AME Church.

Elizabeth spent most of her adult life in Flint, Michigan, with her then husband, Jimmy Veasey, and their son, Anthony, whom she called Tony. She joined New Jerusalem Baptist Church in 1969 and served faithfully as an usher, a Sunday School teacher, and was superintendent of the Sunday School for two years. Elizabeth was a firm believer in the power of education. She came to Flint as a high school graduate and worked in a clerical position at a doctor's office. However, she was determined to get a college education and become a social worker. She graduated from Mott Community College at the age of 40

with an associate degree in Applied Science/Social Work Technician. She kept going and received her BA in Sociology/Social Work from the University of Michigan-Flint at the age of 47. She achieved her dream of becoming a licensed clinical social worker after earning a Master of Social Work degree at the age of 54 from Wayne State University. Elizabeth had a wonderful career as a social worker, retiring from Genesee County. She had a special interest in helping people with substance abuse issues. She was active with community service organizations and maintained a small counseling practice after retirement. Her own professional journey was inspirational, and she made it her mission to encourage Tony and countless family members and friends to never give up on getting an education.

Elizabeth was affectionately known as "Ike" or "Liz" by her family and friends. She was a lot of fun to be around and had the loudest laugh in the room. She was a devoted mother, sister, and aunt, and enjoyed nothing more than being with her family. She and her son Tony worked together to keep the Harris family reunions going and she never missed one until her health prevented her from attending. Toward the end of her life when she lived in Illinois, she enjoyed short, regular FaceTime calls with family members and played card games with her great-great-nieces when they visited. She participated regularly in activities with the residents at her facility. Her last birthday party there included some of her favorite things: cupcakes, B.B. King music playing loudly in the background, and people all around her.

Elizabeth Harris departed this life on November 6, 2025, at the age of 87. She was preceded in death by her parents, Frank and Bamma Harris, and her son, Anthony Dereck Harris-Veasey. She also was preceded in death by her brothers: Johnnie Lee, Howard, Walter, Frank Jr., Lawrence, Marion "Buster", Arthur, George, Thomas, O.V., Charles, Fred, Waymond, and James. Her sisters also preceded her in death: Carrie, Clara, Anna Bernice, Eura Lee, and Annie Jean.

Elizabeth leaves to cherish her memories, many nephews and nieces, including Tramell (Gail) who was her caregiver after her son passed away; many beloved cousins, her dear sisters-in-law: Bernestine Harris of Clio, Leola Harris of Holly, Alice Harris of Romulus, and Verlenda Peeples-Harris of Monticello AR; and a host of other relatives and dear friends.
