In 1952 she accepted Christ into her life and became a member of Christ Temple Apostolic Church in Fort Wayne, Indiana. The family moved to Flint in 1966 from Fort Wayne, Indiana. Ella was a faithful member and Mother at Eliezer Apostolic Church and Refuge Temple Church. She loved getting up "early" each morning to pray and read her Bible. Ella retired from the Flint Community Schools in 1992.
