Mrs. Ella May Hunt Wright was born September 8, 1932 in Wisner, Louisiana, the daughter of Sylvester and Mollie Stuart Hunt. Ella graduated from high School in Jonesville, L.A. Mother Wright received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Social Science and English from Grambling State University, graduating Cum Laude and Honors in Social Science. She taught school in the Catahoula Parish School System before moving to Flint. Mother Wright was a member of Christ Fellowship Baptist Church. She sang with the Voices of Christ Fellowship, served in the Mother's Ministry, served as Director of Christian Education and was a former Sunday School teacher and usher. She was also a member of the Ophelia Bonner Scholarship Fund Committee. Mother Wright was a Parent Volunteer with the Flint School District for many years. She was also a charter member of the Milton Mayes Title 1 Parent

Scholarship Fund of the Flint School District. She was a Life Member of the National Coalition of Title 1 Chapter 1 Parents, and a member of Flint NIPP Board of Directors.
