JONES, Mr. Elliott - Age 68, passed away Monday, June 10, 2013 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Monday, June 17, 2013 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Mr. Elliott Julius Jones was born April 29, 1945 in Birmingham, Alabama, the son of Eloise and Julius Jones. Elliott was a resident of Flint. He was a graduate of Southwestern, "Class of 1963" and Wilberforce University. Elliott served as a Vietnam Veteran and received an Honorable Discharge. Mr. Jones was the owner of Northeast Construction and was employed by the Flint Board of Education and General Motors. He attended Elshaddai C.O.G.I.C. and Eliezer C.O.G.I.C., and enjoyed singing, sports and cooking.
