Mrs. Elzie Mae Clemons was born a twin and the third child to the parents of James and Maudie Warren in Itawanba County, Mississippi on September 15, 1929. Her first brother was still born and her twin brother died at childbirth. Due to the death of her mother shortly after childbirth, she was reared by her father and an older sister, Lillian Cummings. At the age of six years her eldest sister, Beatrice Bonds took her to Jackson, TN where she spent all of her school age years and completed North Jackson Elementary School, Merry High School and Lane College. Following her graduation from Lane College, she taught in many communities in Tennessee. Elzie accepted Christ at the age of 11 years old and united with Macedonia Baptist Church in Jackson, TN. Her love for the Lord and her dedication to her faith were evident as she actively served in the church as musician for the Macedonia Junior Choir and other Church Choirs in the community. She also served as a Sunday school

teacher, a member of the young adult choir and was active in the Missionary Society. Elzie married Ostrich Clemons, a military man in 1953 and traveled with him throughout Europe and on various assignments in the U.S., including Fort Knox, KY, Fort Dix, NJ and Ft. Braggs, NC. She continued her teaching career on the military bases until her husband's retirement.
